



All Years By Country




All Years

Number of Different Dances Taught During Ethnic Sunday and Advanced Sessions, by Year (does not include Workshops)





Percentage of Non-Partner vs Partner Dances of Dances Taught During Ethnic Sunday and Advanced Sessions, by Year
